

Note 1: The DNP/9200 Linux kernel versions 2.4 and 2.6 are using different flash file systems (JFFS = Journalling Flash File System). The DNP/9200 Linux 2.4 comes with JFFS1. Linux 2.6 is running with JFFS2. If there was any write access within the 2.4 kernel to the DNP/9200 **/flash** directory, please use

```
erase 1:2-127
```

instead of

```
erase 1:2-31
```

The command line parameter “**1:2-127**” clears all files within the DNP/9200 **/flash** directory. So please take care that you don’t lose important data.
